LOCATION: Moriarty High School, Moriarty, New Mexico

DATE: April 27-28, 2007

SPONSOR: Moriarty High School Army JROTC

EVENTS:

PRECISION: Individual – 3x20 + Final

SPORTER: Individual – 3x20 + Final

Precision & Sporter Team Competitions will be “unfired” matches comprised of Individual 3x20 scores (not finals)

TIME SCHEDULE: Relays on Friday 4/27 are at 1400 and 1630. Relays on Sat 4/28 are at 0800, 1030, 1300 with finals beginning at approx. 1500 on Saturday

EQUIPMENT: Events will be fired on AR 5/10 Targets. Air Rifles and equipment must conform to the 2006-2008 National 3-Position Air Rifle Council Rules. Schools and clubs should plan on providing their own mats, and scopes. MOHS may be able to provide this equipment by prior arrangement with Maj. Thomas.

CLASSES: There are separate competition classes for Sporter and Precision air rifles. A competitor may only fire in one class.

COMPETITION OPEN TO: All competitors that are members of the NMJSSA-East District schools and clubs. These schools/clubs are eligible to enter competitors: Albuquerque High School Army JROTC, Highland High School Navy JROTC, Manzano High School Navy JROTC, Moriarty High School Army JROTC, and the Valencia County 4-H Shooting Sports Club. Competitors must meet all of the individual school/club requirements for Air Rifle Competition.

RULES: This is a sanctioned CMP match and the *National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules* will apply.

AWARDS: Individual Medals and Ribbons will be awarded to the top scoring individuals in both Precision and Sporter classes. “All District” patches will be awarded to the top individuals in both Precision and Sporter classes. 1st thru 5th place Team Trophies will be awarded in the Sporter class.

In addition individual CMP Gold, Silver, and Bronze achievement pins will be awarded to any competitor that fires at or above the National cutoff score in both the Precision and Sporter classes.

RANGE LOCATION: Moriarty Annex Gym Air Rifle Range

From Central Ave in Moriarty: South on HWY 41 to Center Street. East on Center to the Annex Gym

ENTRY FEES: Entry Fees have already been paid by the East District Schools and Clubs.

NATIONAL 3-P AIR RIFLE ACHIEVEMENT PIN CUTOFF SCORES

Gold, Silver, and Bronze CMP Achievement Pins will be awarded to all competitors that equal or meet the following scores in the individual portions of this 3x20 competition:

	SPORTER CLASS	PRECISION CLASS
GOLD	490+	560+
SILVER	440-489	540-559
BRONZE	400-439	500-539

Gold Achievement Pin scores recognize scores ranking in the 7th percentile or higher on a national basis.

Silver Achievement Pin scores recognize scores ranking in the 20th percentile or higher.

Bronze Achievement Pin scores recognize sporter and precision class scores that rank at the 40th percentile or higher among all competitors in the country.
